Plans for:	Erin's Law in CCS	Timeline
Employees	ALL CCS Employees will be trained in Erin's Law requirements and child sexual abuse prevention, and handling of child sexual abuse disclosures through the Child Abuse Mandated Reporters Training offered by the Alabama Department of Human Resources at <a href="mailto:ttp://training.dhr.alabama.gov/">ttp://training.dhr.alabama.gov/</a>	July-August of each school year
Students	School counselors and/or teachers will provide lessons for PreK through Grade 12 students. Additional personnel may also be utilized.	Annually
*	At a minimum, one lesson per year will be taught using Erin's Law Curriculum for Calhoun County Schools. This curriculum is culturally sensitive and includes active learning participation, including discussions, modeling, and role playing. This will provide students with 13-14 specific, grade appropriate lessons over the course of their educational career in Calhoun County Schools.  Additional lessons will be taught throughout the year in	
	classroom guidance to support these topics. Content may also be included in the Health Teachers' classes.	
Peer-to-Peer	As per the recommendations found in the "Governor's Task Force on Prevention of Sexual Abuse for Children," we will hold an orientation for all middle and high school students regarding 'peer-to-peer' sexual abuse crimes. Additional resources for this could include the School Resource Officer (SRO), school principal, Child Advocacy Centers, the Alabama Department of Human Resources, District Attorney's office, etc.	Annually
Parents	Parental notification will be included in the Student Handbook stating the law and its requirements. Information will also be posted on Calhoun County Schools' system website and each school's website. Following each session, there is a take-away newsletter for parents to further understand the topic discussed and additional conversation pieces.	Annually
